## SUMMER SEASON

I'm glad that so many people have indicated that they appreciate the scripture reading plans I've put together. We have read Luke-Acts. Now we are inviting you to spend your summer with the Psalms. Later in the newsletter you will find a schedule to use through the months of June-August. Most days two Psalms will be read, and if you follow this plan, by the end of the summer you will have finished the book.

As you read, you may discover an unusual word. It first pops up in Psalm 3. The word is *selah*. This is a Hebrew word that the Harper's Bible Dictionary describes as "a word of uncertain derivation and unknown origin and meaning." In other words, nobody knows what this little word means or why it is in the Bible! Scholars guess it might be some kind of musical notation—like a rest or a pause for narration or instrumental accompaniment. But nobody knows, and the Bible Dictionary entry on it concludes, "any attempt to divine it must remain speculative."

First, I love that. I love that for thousands of years there has been this mystery embedded in the Bible. It's a great reminder that no matter how many times you read it, there is always more to be gained from the scriptures, more to wonder at. Second, I like the idea that the word *selah* represents a kind of pause. There is no doubt we all need that from time to time—a pause, a rest, a break.

We need that from time to time, a moment to rest. God made us so that we need to rest for a good chunk of every day, and one day out of every seven. Summer becomes that for many of us too, a time to slow down the pace of life for a while, vacation if possible, and recreate.

May your summers be restful and renewing.

### Joyful Noise 2016

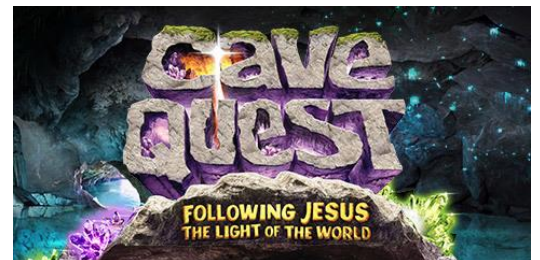

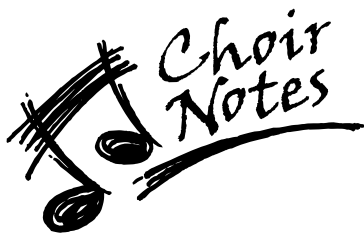
## **St. PAUL'S MISSION UPDATE**

## **HOMWORK CLUB**

St. Paul's new mission, *The Homework Club*, has made a difference in our community. The guidance counselors and principals at our target schools have thanked us for our efforts and encouraged us to continue. From February through May, 12 tutors, mostly from St. Paul's, have met with children at the Historic Sykesville Colored Schoolhouse on Monday and Wednesday afternoons. The kids are a lively bunch, ranging in age from six through 12. After enjoying a healthy snack, they haul out their homework and we assist them. When they giggle, "I don't have any homework!" we are ready with games and enrichment activities. Each session ends with a hands-on craft or science project. Most of the children live in the subsidized Schoolhouse Road townhouses, so they are able to take their school bus home and walk to the Schoolhouse. We would like to continue the effort in September. We can always use more tutors and more snack providers. Tutors do not need to come every session, but many have bonded with a particular child and show up consistently. Youth are also great tutors! Please consider serving in this way. You will help a child and come away feeling enriched yourself. 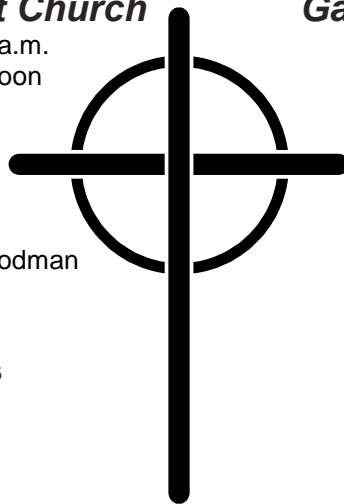
